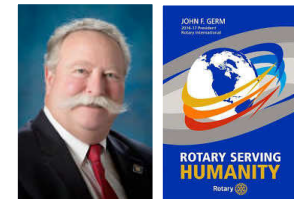

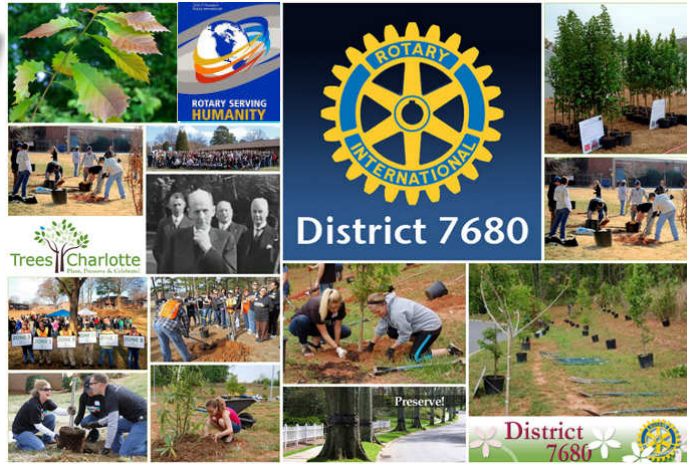




## Rotary District 7680 partners with TreesCharlotte to restore Charlotte's beautiful canopy
