PLANNING EFFORTS

- Efforts began before we had first case
- February/March 2020
- Pandemic influenza response plan
- International travel
- Policy group
- Emergency operations center (Eoc)
- Scenario planning
- Joint information center (JIC)

CRISIS BEGINS

- March 10, 2020
- Governor Cooper declares state of emergency
- March 11, 2020
- Mecklenburg County has its first presumptive case of covid-19
- March 13, 2020
- State of emergency declared in Mecklenburg County
- March 14, 2020
- Public health order prohibiting mass gatherings in excess of 100 people
- Mecklenburg County has seven presumptive cases of covid-19

CRISIS CONTINUES

- Homeless residents
- Childcare for first responders
- County services
- Voluntary organizations active in disasters (VOAD)
- Case count doubled in three days - March 20 County had 45 presumptive cases of COVID-19
- March 26 – Countywide stay at home proclamation goes into effect
- First county in the state to issue an proclamation
- Strong Alignment between county, city, six towns
- March 30 – Governor Cooper’s stay at home order goes into effect
- In 19 days cases increase from one to 376

- Field hospital: April 2 to April 15
- Request for 3,000 bed facility at UNCC
- Request for 600 bed facility at Charlotte Convention Center
- Request for field hospital withdrawn
- April 16 – Mecklenburg County had 1,098 cases of covid-19
- Projected peak flattened and moved out from early may to mid-July

- April 16 County stay at home proclamation extended to April 29
- April 29 – Governor extends stay at home order to May 8
- Announces three phased reopening plan
- May 8 - Mecklenburg County had 2,007 cases of COVID-19
- Moved through phase 1

- May 22 – Governor's phase 2 goes into effect
- Safer at home
- Increased commercial & retail activity
- Personal care businesses
- Restaurants & breweries
- Pools & day camps

- Percent of total tests that come back positive
- Number of hospitalizations

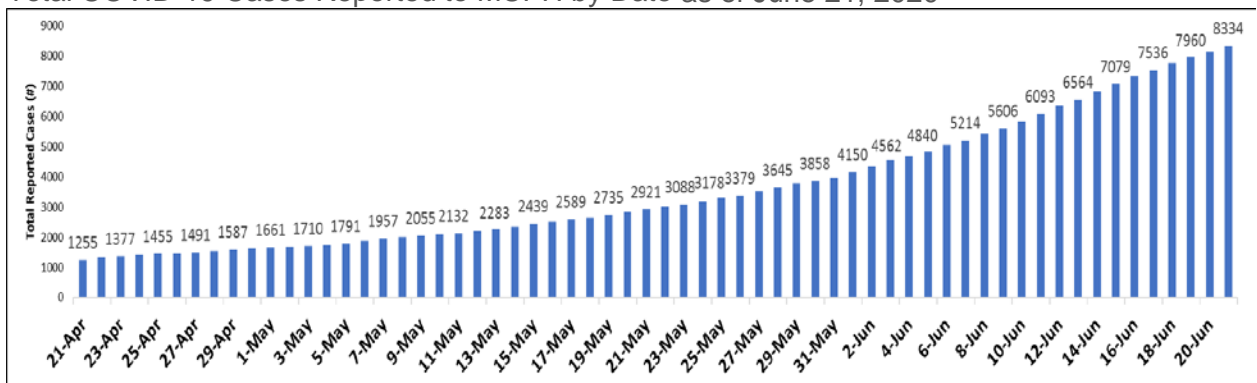
Testing

- 2,500 tests per day

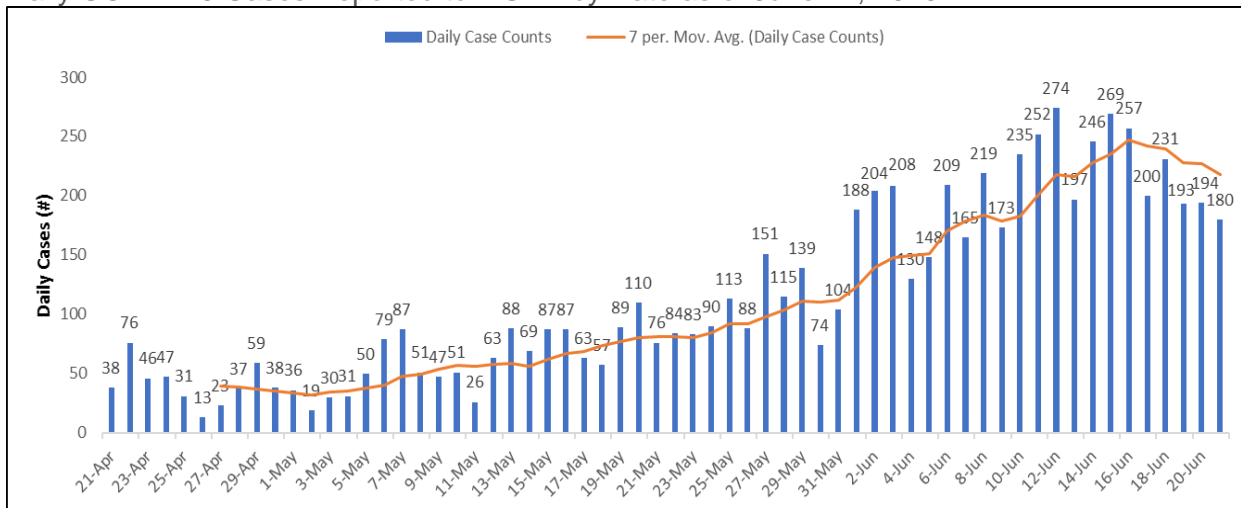
Contact tracing

- Mecklenburg County has 170 people trained in contact tracing

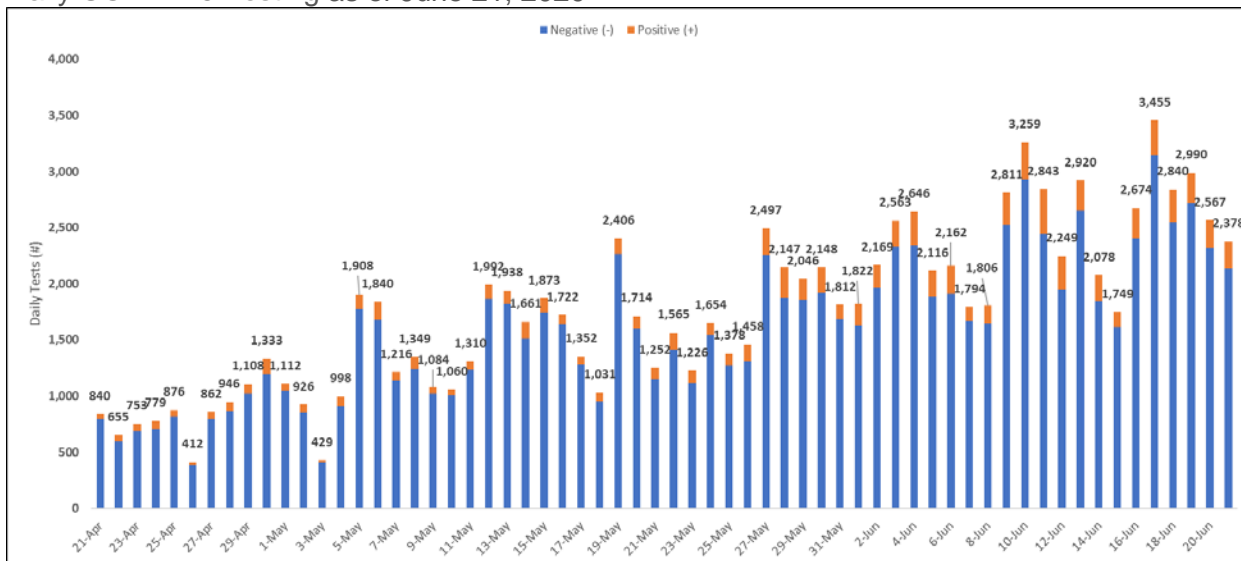
Total COVID-19 Cases Reported to MCPH by Date as of June 21, 2020



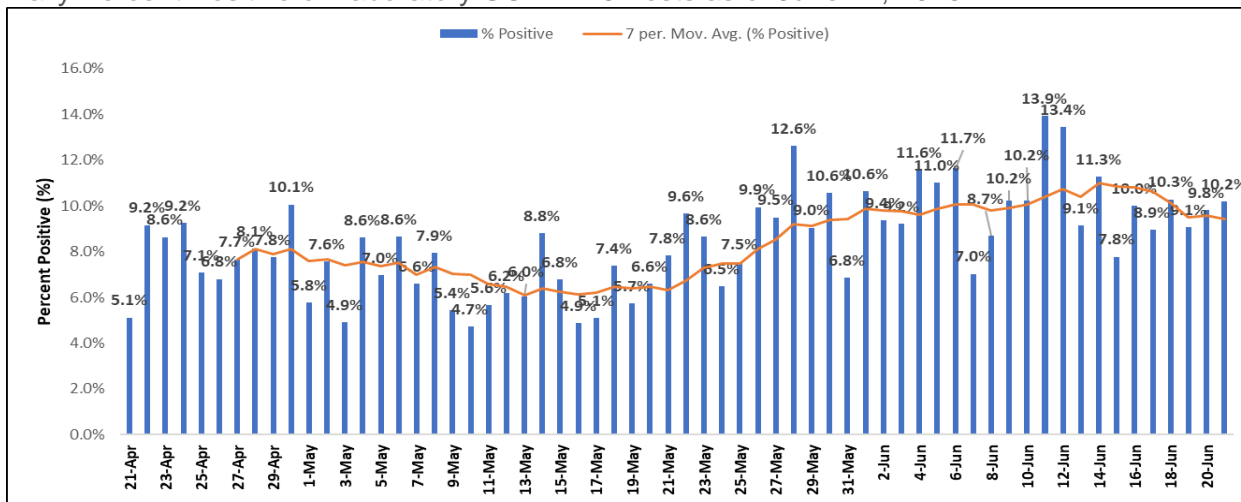
Daily COVID-19 Cases Reported to MCPH by Date as of June 21, 2020



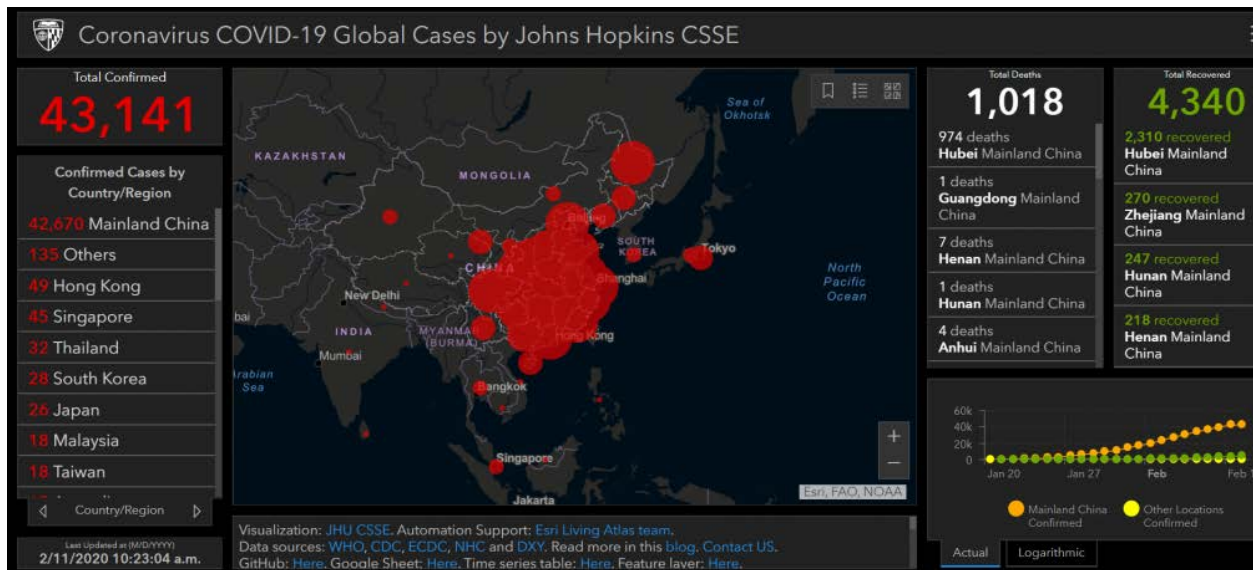
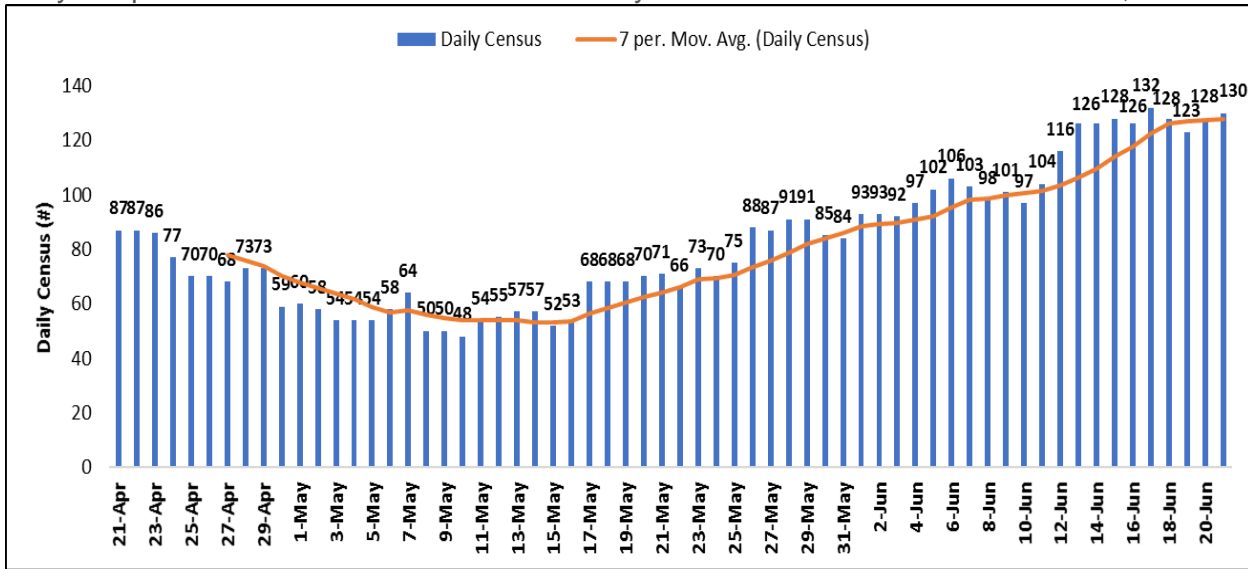
Daily COVID-19 Testing as of June 21, 2020
