Meg McElwain and Tim Newman spoke of how faith, family and friends lifted them through tough times while Colleen Brannon acknowledged them as underpinnings of her continued success.

"I really believe, if you put your faith in the Lord, He will not leave you," said Meg, whose second child Mitchell was diagnosed with leukemia when he was three months old. She's thankful for Myers Park United

Methodist Church and its ministry to her husband Frank Turner, her older son Frank Jr. and herself.

She's grateful to friends in Rotary, and especially for the coordination of their efforts by Sandy Osborne. She also gave thanks for caregiver Pat Sloan, Eastover Pediatrics and Dr. Mike Giftos. Further, she listed Presbyterian Hemby Children's Hospital, its nurses and its "loving and wonderful staff," who outfitted her with an office at the hospital where she could pursue the projects of her firm, Magnolia Marketing.

Best of all, she said, Mitchell is in remission. Though recurrence chances are high, she said, "I know he's going to be OK...and he's going to have a wonderful life."

Tim dealt with the loss of his job leading the Charlotte Regional Visitors Authority and with highly public court appearances related to driving violations.

Tim acknowledged the family of his former wife and "parenting partner," his mother and the family of his new companion. He's happy for the straight A's daughter Rebecca is earning at Clemson University. Meanwhile, he is overjoyed with the enrollment in high school for his twin 16-year-old sons, William and David. Though they struggle with autism, he said, they are accomplishing major milestones in coping.

More than anything, Tim leans on his faith. He recited Bible verses from Thessalonians and Corinthians that he said carry him through daily stress.

"When you're feeling sorry for yourself, do something nice for somebody else," he advised. "Your life will be a lot better."

Colleen assured the Rotarians that her mom and dad instilled principles she's used to succeed. She's grateful for husband Scott and children Nicholas and Phoebe – and even puppy Karma.

"Being a mom is the best job ever," said the owner of Branstorm PR & Marketing.

She's thankful for her friends, those she's known since childhood as well as those she's found in Charlotte.

"Charlotte has everything you need to raise a family and have a good job," she told her audience. "Charlotte embraces entrepreneurs."

On a lighter note, Colleen said she's grateful for her health, although she implied that – occasionally – her diet might include fast food and strong drink. Perhaps she's fortunate to count another blessing – she's her own boss.
