EXPECTATIONS



ATTENDANCE

Rotary International has an attendance policy. Members are required to attend **50% attendance** rate with the opportunity to make up meetings at other Rotary clubs. You will learn more about the make-ups at your orientation meeting. Some time ago the policy was 80%, but it has been relaxed in the last few years.



FINANCIAL

Members of the Rotary Club of Charlotte can expect the following financial obligations. Billing is done quarterly:

\$250 admission fee, \$105 per quarter for dues, \$286 per quarter for meals plus contributions to the Foundation and other projects at your comfort level.



FOUNDATION

Rotary International has a Foundation that helps people across the world. Members of The Rotary Club of Charlotte are expected to give to the Rotary Foundation. The recommended minimum is \$100 per year. Individual members of the Rotary Club of Charlotte contribute from \$25 to \$1,000 per year.



COMMITTEES

Members of The Rotary Club of Charlotte are expected to serve on one or two committees. There are over 40 committees and you will learn more about these at the new member orientation. There is something for everyone.



PROJECTS

Rotary's motto is "**Service above Self.**"

The Rotary Club of Charlotte does several community projects each year and members are expected to give of their time and participate in these projects either financially or in person. Past projects have included a habitat house, delivering dictionaries to elementary schools, serving Christmas breakfast to the patrons of the Charlotte Rescue Mission, Fund-raising golf tournament, etc. Some projects become annual events for a while, but there are no permanent projects.
